Welcome to a new edition of our newsletter.

1. Tenders for two rental power projects

Electric Power Generation Enterprise announced today two tenders for the “purchasing of electricity on rental basis” for five years in Kyaukse and in Myingyan. The bids are to be submitted until 19 February 2018, 2pm (which is a very tight schedule, but interested parties must make an effort to stick to it; in a similar tender in 2016, no extension was granted). The tender winner for each site should be able to sell 100MW.

A similar tender was called in 2016 for the sale of 300MW in Yangon. Two providers for 600MW in total were in the end selected, but as the Ministry of Electricity and Energy had invited the tender without budget approval, we are still to see any electricity generation from it. We very much suppose that there will be no such issue this time.
