
**Issuance of the list of goods which are allowed to be sold through wholesale and retail

Subject: Issuance of a list of prioritised goods which are allowed to be sold through wholesale and retail by foreign companies and companies established as a joint venture between Myanmar citizens and foreigners

1. The Ministry of Commerce issued Notification No. 25/2018 on 9 May 2018 with rules allowing foreign companies and companies established as a joint venture between Myanmar citizens and foreigners to engage in retail and wholesale business within the country.
2. The list of goods which are allowed to be sold according to this Notification through wholesale and retail within the country by foreign companies and companies established as a joint venture between Myanmar citizens and foreigners is specified as attached so that it be known which items are permitted.
3. The list of prioritised goods which are allowed to be sold through wholesale and retail may be amended and issued according to the needs of the country.

List of prioritised goods allowed to be sold through wholesale and retail by foreign companies and companies established as a joint venture between Myanmar citizens and foreigners

1. Consumer goods (including clothes, clocks and watches, cosmetics)
2. Foodstuff including the following items-
 - (a) Agricultural products (except goods that are not allowed to be imported based on the needs of the country);
 - (b) aquatic products;
 - (c) animal products;
 - (d) instant food;
 - (e) different types of beverages;
 - (f) liquor manufactured domestically;
3. household goods (including enamel ware, earthenware, glassware, glass);
4. goods used in the kitchen;
5. pharmaceuticals and hospital equipment;
6. animal feed and veterinary drugs;
7. stationary;
8. furniture;
9. sports goods;
10. goods used in communication (including cameras and phones);
11. electronic goods;
12. construction materials and equipment;
13. electric goods;
14. chemical products for industrial use;



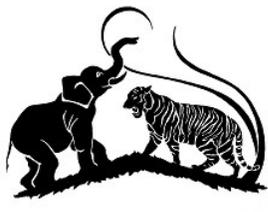
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15. seeds, agricultural supplies, materials used in agriculture;
16. machines used in agriculture;
17. various types of machines and accessories thereto;
18. various types of bicycles;
19. various types of motorcycles and accessories thereto;
20. spare parts for motor vehicles and heavy machinery;
21. toys;
22. materials for home decoration (including flowers and plants);
23. souvenirs and handicraft;
24. Artwork, musical instruments and accessories thereto (except antiques).

Remarks:

1. With regard to the retail and wholesale sale of the items mentioned above, value-added products that are domestically manufactured shall be sold with priority with the retail and wholesale permit.
2. With regard to the import and sale of imported goods, the laws, rules, procedures and conditions of the relevant ministry shall be complied with for each item.
3. The list of prioritised goods to be sold may be amended and issued based on the needs of the country.
