Welcome to a new edition of our newsletter.

#### 1. Union Tax Law

The Union Tax Law (Pyidaungsu Hluttaw Law No. 29/2019) was enacted on 24<sup>th</sup> September 2019. It applies to the 2019/20 financial year (i.e., the period from 1<sup>st</sup> October 2019 to 30<sup>th</sup> September 2020).

The most important changes are:

### (a) Special Goods Tax

Special goods tax rates have been changed for several goods:

With regard to gemstones, taxes are now levied according to the Gemstones Law (Pyidaungsu Hluttaw Law No. 4/2019) instead of the Special Goods Tax Law and the Commercial Tax Law. The tax rates range from 5% to 11%.

#### (b) Commercial Tax

There are some tweaks in the lists of exempted goods and exempted services.

The exemption threshold of Ks. 50 million now applies to the 12 month period(s) following commencement of the business, not to the financial year.

The Union Tax Law introduces the following penalties for failure to issue vouchers with (correct) tax stickers: first offence Ks. 500,000; second offence Ks. 1,000,000; third offence Ks. 1,500,000; fourth offence Ks. 2,000,000. Furthermore, failure to attach stickers to goods to which they should be attached carries a penalty of 100% of the value of the goods.

#### (c) Income tax

The law has reduced the rates on hitherto untaxed income used for "buying, constructing, acquiring, establishing a new business or expanding a business". This is a slimmed-down version of a tax amnesty that was proposed last year but ultimately not adopted. The hope is that it will help channel previously hidden funds into the official economy.

### 2. Draft Petroleum Exploration, Drilling and Production Law

The drafter, a now retired director general of the Oil and Gas Planning Department, was on the panel as well.
