**Announcement for commodity
importers and wholesalers amid
outbreak of Coronavirus Disease 2019
(COVID-19)**

3rd Waxing of Kason, 1382 ME
(24 April 2020)

1. Retailed shops and marketplaces have been allowed for systematic functioning, and the movements of vehicles/ persons have been permitted in accordance with the rules and regulations to support the flows of goods and necessary commodities traded in stable prices amid the outbreak of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19)
2. The Ministry of Commerce has also relaxed some processes in coordination with the relevant state-owned agencies and private sector for ensuring easy import of goods.
3. The ministry has not imposed any restrictions on companies/individual traders in their distribution of necessary commodities and household goods to prevent out of stock and soaring prices in the market. Therefore, manufactures (approved by the Ministry of Health and Sports), wholesalers, distributors and importers are informed to run the respective businesses normally.
4. It is also needed to follow the guidelines of Ministry of Health and Sports in doing businesses to prevent transmission of diseases.
