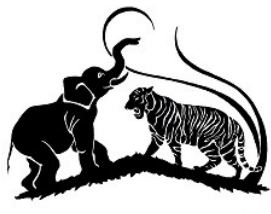
Granting relief according to section 100 Social Security Law 2012 so that workplaces can continue to operate during COVID-19

1. As a consequence of the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) pandemic, CMP factories, workplaces, hotel and tourism businesses and establishments including small and medium enterprises in Myanmar are temporarily or permanently closing their business or reducing their workforce.
2. Therefore, for employers whose workplaces are registered according to the Social Security Law 2012, the following relief is granted during the COVID-19 period.

“The contributions to be paid by the employer and by the worker according to section 18 Social Security Law 2012 and Rule 64 within 15 days after the end of the month for which salary is paid shall now be payable within three months from the end of the month for which salary is paid.”

3. The above provisions shall come into force on the date of this Notification.
