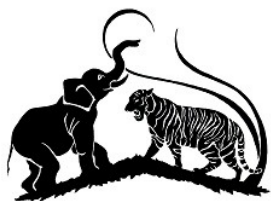

2. The responsibilities of the Committee are as follows:

- (a) arranging for the factory to be completed and operational on time within the specified period;
- (b) with foreign experts, arranging for the timely arrival of machinery and equipment;
- (c) arranging for food, accommodation and health care for foreign experts;

- (d) arranging for the security of foreign experts;
- (e) asking the Russian government to make available technical assistance worth EUR 10.5 million for technical transfer to and a training programme for factory workers, as offered by the Russian government;
- (f) coordinating the implementation of the factory and the construction project with foreign experts;
- (g) helping solve problems and difficulties that may be encountered and satisfying what may be needed;
- (h) supervising the implementation in accordance with prescribed standards of the construction and installation works;
- (i) arranging for a reliable power supply from an independent source as requested by Russia;
- (j) making arrangements for occupational safety;
- (k) reviewing whether funds are systematically spent;
- (l) requesting certificates upon completion of the construction and installation works;
- (m) monitoring whether the installed machinery can be tested at full capacity;
- (n) obtaining a final acceptance certificate (FAC) if the plant has been successfully tested;
- (o) meeting the staffing requirements to operate the factory in 3 shifts;
- (p) facilitating the transfer of technology.
