Date: 10<sup>th</sup> August 2022

Subject: Setting a trading band in relation to the purchase price and sales price in the sale, purchase and exchange in the foreign currency market

- 1. When banks with an authorised dealer (AD) license, banks with a money changer (MC) license, and companies and organisations with a money changer (MC) license that are not banks sell, purchase or exchange foreign currency, and when companies with an offshore remittance license transfer foreign currency to or from a destination abroad, they are instructed to do this at a foreign exchange rate within a bandwidth of ± 0.3% from the CBM reference rate (CBM Reference Rate ± 0.3%).
- 2. Be notified that action will be taken according to the Foreign Exchange Management Law and Regulations if this limit is exceeded.
- 3. This Directive shall enter into effect on 10<sup>th</sup> August 2022.
