Welcome to a new edition of our newsletter.

For the first time: Feed-in tariff for small-scale solar systems

The Electricity Supply Enterprise and the Yangon Electricity Supply Corporation announced feed-in tariffs as below for small-scale solar systems in Nay Pyi Taw and Yangon on 17 March and 21 April 2023, respectively (English translation).

Sr. no.	Installed generation capacity	Power tariff
1	100 KW to 1 MW	MMK 85 / kWh
2	More than 1 MW to 10 MW	MMK 80 / kWh

This is a first. We understand that previously, off-grid producers sometimes managed on a case-by-case basis to negotiate a connection to the national grid and a power purchase agreement for excess electricity, but as a general rule, authorities seem to have been reluctant to connect small-scale producers to the grid as "it wasn't designed for it". The current massive power cuts during the dry season may have prompted a change of approach.

Apart from the tariffs themselves, technical and commercial details still do not seem to have been hammered out.

Operators of rooftop and other small-scale solar systems wishing to connect and sell excess electricity to the grid (once further details are available) should discuss system requirements with a knowledgeable engineer. We understand that conventional grid-tie inverters (the device that converts the variable direct current output from a solar panel into 230V alternating current) shut down during power cuts. Those having tied their solar system to the national grid and wishing to use solar energy during power cuts will need a hybrid solution.
