Union Consultative Council Law
(National Defence and Security Council Law No. 3/2026)

1387, 2nd Waning Day of Tabodwe
(3 February 2026)

Exercising the legislative power of the Union Parliament according to article 427 of the Constitution of the Republic of the Union of Myanmar, the National Defence and Security Council has enacted this law.

Chapter 1
Title and definitions

1. This law shall be referred to as Union Consultative Council Law.
2. The following expressions in this law shall have the meanings given hereunder:
 - (a) **“State”** means the Republic of the Union of Myanmar.
 - (b) **“Council”** means the Union Consultative Council established according to this law.


Chapter 2
Objectives

3. The objectives of this law are as follows:
 - (a) To strengthen a genuine and multi-party democracy;
 - (b) to build a Union based on democracy and federalism;
 - (c) to ensure national prosperity;
 - (d) to ensure food and water supply in abundance.

Chapter 3
Assignment of duties

4. Without prejudice to the powers vested separately by the Constitution of the Republic of the Union of Myanmar into the executive branch and the judicial branch, the Union Parliament authorises the President to establish the Council to enable it to advise on and coordinate,

according to the objectives of this law, matters related to the security and rule of law of the Union, matters related to international relations, matters related to peace, and matters related to legislation.

5. The President shall establish the Council consisting of not less than five members, including the chairman and the secretary, from among suitable persons.
6. When establishing the Council, the President shall designate the chairman and the secretary.
7. The President shall determine the duties and powers of the Council concerning the matters referred to in section 4.


Chapter 4 Miscellaneous

8. The Union Government shall determine the monthly honorarium, allowance, insignia and benefits of the Council members.
9. The term of office of the Council shall be the same as that of the President.
10. The Office of the President shall make arrangements for the office work of the Council.
11. The Office of the President may issue rules, orders, notifications and directives as may be necessary to implement the provisions of this law.
