Welcome to a new edition of our newsletter.

1. E-visa extension available again

On 29 August 2025, the Ministry of Immigration and Population under the National Defence and Security Council [announced](#) that starting from 1 September 2025, holders of embassy-issued business visas, business visas on arrival and business e-visas may apply again [online](#) for one extension of their visa for 3, 6 or 12 months.

Applications may be filed until the 10th day of overstaying (but overstay fines of USD 3 per day apply, to be paid in cash at the Immigration Department's Stay Extension Section at No. 122, Pansodan Street, Kyauktada Township).

Only one extension is possible through this method; subsequent extensions must be applied for with a DICA (or MIC) recommendation letter.

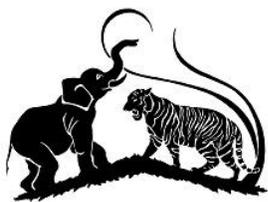

Processing fees must be paid online with Visa, Master or JCB card within 10 days from the date of the payment notification (pre-approval letter) e-mail:

3-month stay permit	62 USD
6-month stay permit	114 USD
1-year stay permit	217 USD
Single re-entry visa	72 USD
Multiple re-entry visa	217 USD

The following must be attached to the online application:

- Passport photo;
- scanned copy of the bio-data page in the applicant's passport (still valid for at least 6 months);
- scanned copy of the passport page with the most recent entry stamp;
- extension request letter signed by a registered director of the sponsoring company ([template](#));

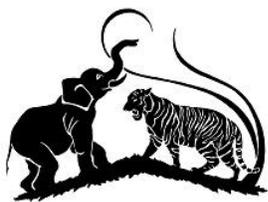
- scanned copy of the certificate of incorporation;
- Scanned copy of the company extract (status must be “registered”);
- if the company’s business is related to a ministry, recommendation letter from this ministry;
- if the business is classified as a small and medium enterprise, business licence and recommendation letter from the Immigration Department’s Head in the relevant Region or State ([template](#)), to be issued only after a field inspection;
- scanned copy of the applicant’s Form C (“Report of Arrival”);
- scanned copy of the applicant’s Foreigner Registration Certificate (FRC). If the applicant does not have an FRC, he must obtain it from the Foreigner Registration Section at No. 122, Pansodan Street prior to the stay permit/re-entry visa stickers being affixed.

Successful applicants must visit the Stay Extension Section at 122, Pansodan Street within 14 working days from the date of payment confirmation to have the stay permit/re-entry visa stickers affixed in their passports.

2. Export/import seminar
