Welcome to a new edition of our newsletter.

Private fuel vehicles to be used only on alternate days

In the evening of 3 March 2026, the National Defence and Security Council announced that starting from 7 March 2026 until further notice, private fuel vehicles may only be used on alternate days, to conserve fuel due to the situation in the Middle East.

On dates ending with an odd number (1, 3, 5, 7, 9), only vehicles with odd-numbered license plates (relevant is apparently the number in the number/letter combination before the hyphen, e.g., "1P-") are permitted to be driven, and on dates ending with an even number (2, 4, 6, 8, 0), only vehicles with even-numbered license plates are permitted to be driven.

Electric vehicles, vehicles for public transport such as buses and taxis, and certain other vehicles are exempted.



Public announcement on the economical use of fuel

Nay Pyi Taw, March 3rd

1. Due to military conflict in the Middle East because of the current global political situation, obstacles, obstructions and blockages are occurring in the waterways used by ships that transport fuel for import.



2. Due to the above circumstances, private vehicles, commercial vehicles and transport vehicles will be required to operate according to the following terms and conditions starting from 7 March 2026, to save fuel and ensure sufficient supply:
 - (a) Private vehicles with an even number (e.g., 2A/---, 4A/---, etc.) may only be driven on an “even” day of the month, and private vehicles with an odd number (e.g., 1A/--, 3A/---, etc.) may only be driven on an “odd” day of the month. (Electric vehicles/electric motorcycles may be driven on any day.)
 - (b) Vehicles for public transport, taxis, vehicles for fuel transport, construction vehicles, vehicles for cargo transport, ambulances/hearses, and municipal garbage collection vehicles may be used on any day.
 - (c) Not only fuel business owners, but also the general public may under no circumstances buy and stockpile fuel or sell it at inflated prices.
3. Therefore, it is hereby announced that the above terms and conditions are in effect until further notice and that any violation of these terms and conditions will be subject to action according to the laws in force.
