MIC investments may be made in CNY

On 16 March 2026, the Myanmar Investment Commission under the National Defence and Security Council announced that foreign investors may contribute investment capital in Chinese yuan (CNY), in addition to US dollars. Previously, only US dollar investments were permitted.

1. To facilitate investments and meet the need of investors, Chinese yuan (CNY) are accepted in addition to United States dollars (USD) as foreign investment capital when proposals and applications for endorsements are submitted to the office of the Myanmar Investment Commission.
2. It is hereby announced that remittances for an investment may be made through banks licenced to deal in foreign currency (AD banks) in United States dollars (USD) if the investor contributes foreign investment capital in United States dollars (USD), and in Chinese yuan (CNY) if the contribution is made in Chinese yuan (CNY).
